Dear Letha:

I am sending you some more information on James Calvin Wilson that I thought you might like to have. I don't have anything on his first marriage--didn't know he had been married before, but since you brought it to my attention can see that he must of been. Do you know anything at all about his first marriage--her name or where they were married or any other little thing?

My great-grandmother Rebecca Jane Farmer Seybert's mother is supposed to have been an Amos. Rebecca was married to Samuel Jackson "Sam" Seybert. In the census of 1860 of Dade County Missouri Rachel Jane (wife of William King Farmer Jr.) is listed as age 20 and Rebecca Jane is listed as age 10 so it isn't very likely that she was Rebecca's mother. (In the 1870 census Rebecca is listed again as being only 10 years older than Rachel Jane). William King Farmer must have been married before he married Rachel Jane. Can you help on this one? Could he have been married to one of Rachel Jane's sisters?

This was an error I made in putting together the Francis M. Wilson family --Alice, daughter of Francis M. Wilson did not marry Nathaniel Butterfield she would have been only 3 or 4 years old in 1873; so you can mark that one off.

The census on Emsley Montgomery I thought your husband might like to have. I have the census books on Dade County from 1850 to 1880 and the 1860 census of Cedar County. The census of 1890 were almost all destroyed in a fire.

William Wilson and Ellen don't seem to be in any of the Dade County census.

My half--brother, Victor A. Underwood is a descendant of William H. Montgomery and Alvina Seybert. His lineage is as follows:

Bud was not married like his brother, James T. (her grandfather) and offered to take the blame for it. He went to Texas and was never heard from again!"
