

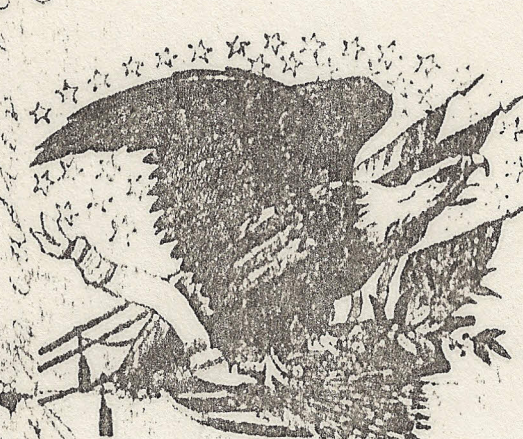

during the war, is hereby **Discharged** from the service of the United States,
this Thirtieth day of June, 1865, at Springfield
Missouri by reason of expiration of term of service
(No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)

in the State of Missouri, is 18 years of age,
5 feet 7 inches high, fair complexion, Blue eyes,
Light hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a farmer
