 thirty three cents each all the rest of residue to be equally divided among
 my sons & daughters Nancy Emily James Sally Eliza Robert & Potty it
 under Oath that the first three mentioned to have thirty three dollars &
 thirty three cents each & the residue of their equal part with the rest
 sealed and delivered in the presence of them under my hand & Seal
 this 19th day of March 1820
